## SOIL CONDITIONS

- **Moist, well-drained soil:** not too wet or too dry; water percolates through easily, not heavy clay or sand. Use organic matter such as compost, peat moss or aged manure to amend soil if necessary.
- **Drought tolerant:** means once the plant has been established: all plants require sufficient water when first planted the first few years to help the plant get rooted in.

## PLANT ZONE

- Southern Alberta is classified as Zone 4 on the Agriculture Canada Plant Hardiness Zone map. While many Zone 4 plants do well in Southern Alberta, especially in sheltered areas, rural areas tend to be Zone 3.
- Coaldale Nurseries recommends plants rated for Zone 3 or lower for Southern Alberta.
- Please check the Zone and whether a plant is guaranteed or not before purchasing any plant.

## SUN REQUIREMENTS

- **Full Sun:** minimum of 6 hours of direct sunlight/day
- **Part Sun:** 4-6 hours of direct sunlight/day; including some afternoon sun
- **Part Shade:** 4-6 hours of direct sunlight/day; mostly before midday, protected from midday sun
- **Full Shade:** less than 3 hours of direct sun/day; preferably morning sun

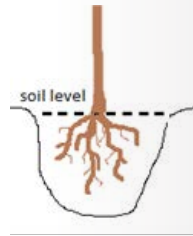
## Planting Instructions

- Choose a plant appropriate for your site.
- After planting, water regularly until the plant is fully established.
- Fertilize newly planted trees with a high phosphorous fertilizer (such as 10-52-10) or with Bone Meal, to encourage root growth, according to product directions.
- Keep weeds and grass away from base of tree/shrub to ensure no competition for water.
- When mulching trees: leave a 2" area around trunk uncovered so bark is not covered with mulch.
- Stake as needed until tree is established: use a strong pole (1-3 poles), and tie loosely with a flexible, soft material. Remove after two years.

### Bare-Root (Trees, Shrubs)

Bare-root plants are only available beginning of April-end May so they have a growing season to establish. Because these plants have an exposed root system they need to be planted as soon as possible. If you are unable to plant them the day of purchase, place plants in a pail and cover roots with water. Keep in a cool, dark place, a day or two at most. Do not let dry out: keep roots moist during planting.

1. Dig a hole at least as large as the root spread. The hole should be large enough that the roots can be spread out and are not crowded. Be sure the part where the trunk meets the roots sits level at the original ground level, no deeper or higher.
2. Backfill the hole with a 1:1 ratio mixture of existing soil and soil amendment (e.g. compost). Water thoroughly: be sure to back fill with more soil as needed as soil settles.
3. Make a well/basin around each newly planted bare-root to help retain moisture.



### Potted (Trees, Shrubs, Perennials)

Potted plants can be planted at any time from spring to fall when the ground is workable, with an exception being extremely hot days (in such a case, plant in the evening or on a cloudy day; water in well.)

1. Dig a hole 2-3 times the size of the container and only just as deep as the rootball.
2. Remove plant from its pot and gently loosen the outer roots to encourage them to spread.
3. Place plant in center of the hole: make sure top of the rootball is level with the original ground level.
4. Back fill the hole with a 1:1 ratio mixture of existing soil and soil amendment (e.g. compost). Water thoroughly: be sure to back fill with more soil as needed as soil settles.
5. Make a well/basin around each newly planted tree or shrub to help retain moisture.

### Caliper/Balled-and-Burlapped (Trees)

Balled and Burlapped trees (also called 'Caliper' trees) are large and very heavy: be sure you know exactly where you want to plant this tree and if possible, dig the hole before tree arrives. Never remove the entire basket and burlap before, during or after planting.

1. Dig a hole (ask nursery for approx. rootball size): about 6-8" wider but no deeper than rootball.
2. Place tree in hole, making sure it is centered and top of rootball is level with original ground level.
3. Remove the white string tying basket together: bend exposed wires back and cut off. Open up any visible burlap and cut off. The burlap will naturally decompose and roots will grow outwards into soil.
4. Back fill the hole with a 1:1 ratio mixture of existing soil and soil amendment (e.g. compost). Water thoroughly: be sure to back fill with more soil as needed as soil settles.
5. Make a well/basin around each newly planted tree to help retain moisture.

Fast-growing. Dark green foliage; spreading upright crown. Purple catkins in spring followed by brown, cone-like seed cases.

**Ash *Fraxinus*** 5 gal \$99.95 7 gal \$129.95 10 gal \$179.95 15 gal \$239.95 Drought tolerant.

**Excel Green Ash *Fraxinus excelsior 'Excel'*** H: 40-50' W: 33-40' Zone: 3 Full Sun Available in caliper size  
Hardy, seedless tree with an upright crown. Green leaflets turn yellow in fall. Plant 12-15' apart as windbreak.

**Prairie Spire Green Ash *Fraxinus pennsylvanica 'Rugby'*** H: 50' W: 23-30' Zone: 2 Full Sun Available in caliper size  
Narrow, compact crown; hardy, seedless variety. Yellow-gold fall colour. Plant 12-15' apart as a windbreak.

**Columnar Guardian Columnar Aspen *Populus x 'Jefguard'*** H: 40' W: 10' Zone: 2 Full Sun  
Seedless, fast growing, columnar tree. Great for windbreak/privacy: plant 5-6' apart. Resistant to BLD.

**Columnar Prairie Skyrise Trembling Aspen *Populus tremuloides 'Prairie Skyrise'*** H: 33-40' W: 5-7' Zone: 2 Full Sun  
Fast growing, very dense, columnar tree. Little to no suckers: great privacy/windbreak. Plant 3-4' apart.

**Columnar Swedish Columnar Aspen *Populus tremula 'Erecta'*** H: 33-40' W: 5-6' Zone: 2 Full Sun Available in caliper size  
Fast growing, columnar tree. Non-suckering, great for privacy and windbreak in urban areas: plant 3-4' apart.

**Quaking/Trembling Aspen *Populus tremuloides*** H: 50' W: 20-26' Zone: 2 Full/Part Sun Available in caliper size  
Rounded, fast growing native tree with smooth, pale bark. Sometimes sold multi-stem. Green, rounded foliage.

**Pike Bay Quaking Aspen *Populus tremuloides 'Pike Bay'*** H: 50' W: 20-30' Zone: 2 Full Sun Available in caliper size  
Fast growing, tall tree. Dark green rounded leaves with smooth, light coloured bark. Yellow fall colour.

**Columnar Dakota Pinnacle Birch *Betula platyphylla 'Fargo'*** H: 20-30' W: 8-10' Zone: 3 Full Sun Available in caliper size  
Columnar tree; green foliage turns yellow in fall. Great for small spaces. White, peeling bark with maturity.

**Paper Birch *Betula papyrifera*** H: 40' W: 20-30' Zone: 2 Full Sun  
Toothed green foliage is yellow in fall. Red bark matures to white, papery texture. Native tree. Sold as single or multi-stem.

**Columnar Parkland Pillar Birch *Betula Platyphylla 'Jefpark'*** H: 26-30' W: 6-8' Zone: 3 Full Sun Available in caliper size  
Columnar, narrow tree. Green foliage turns yellow-gold in fall. White, peeling bark with maturity.

Upright, oval form. Dark green foliage turns yellow in fall. Snow-white, peeling bark with maturity.

Slow-growing, specimen tree with irregular weeping branches. White, peeling bark with maturity.

Top-grafted, weeping, specimen tree. Feathery, fern-like green foliage and yellow blooms in early summer.

White spring blooms mature to ornamental tiny fruit. Exfoliating, red bark; shiny green leaves. Very showy tree.

White spring blooms turn into edible small, sour cherries. Upright, native tree. Reddish bark, shiny green leaves.

Green foliage matures to purple in summer. White spring flowers turn into small, black fruit. Small, oval tree.

**Ambassador Crabapple *Malus 'DurBy'*** H: 24-26' W: 13-14' Zone: 3 Full Sun  
 Pink spring blooms mature to small, purple-red fruit that persist into winter. Narrow, upright tree with burgundy leaves.

**Courageous Crabapple *Malus x 'DurLawrence'*** H: 10-20' W: 5-10' Zone: 2 Full Sun  
 Bright pink spring blooms with little to no fruit. Bronze foliage matures to green. Small, oval tree.

**Dark Knight Crabapple *Malus 'ByFrank'*** H: 20' W: 15-16' Zone: 3 Full Sun  
 Pinkish-red spring blooms are followed by small, red fruit that persist into winter. Compact, upright tree; glossy purple leaves.

**Columnar Emerald Spire Columnar Crabapple *Malus x 'Jefgreen'*** H: 16-20' W: 5-6' Zone: 2 Full Sun  
 Pink buds open to pink-white blooms followed by tiny red fruit. Green, purple-tipped foliage. Columnar tree.

**Gladiator Crabapple *Malus x adstringens 'Durpleo'*** H: 20' W: 10-13' Zone: 2 Full Sun Available in caliper size  
 Pink spring blooms mature to small, purple-red fruit. Bronze-purple foliage. Upright, narrow tree.

**Columnar Green Wall Columnar Crabapple *Malus x 'Jefwall'*** H: 16-20' W: 5-6' Zone: 2 Full Sun  
 Very columnar, hardy specimen tree; glossy green foliage. White spring blooms mature to tiny red fruit that persist into winter.

**Columnar Jade Bouquet Columnar Crabapple *Malus 'Jade Bouquet'*** H: 16' W: 5-6' Zone: 3 Full Sun  
 Bright white spring blooms mature to small, bright red fruit. Columnar, upright tree with dark green foliage.

**Makamik Crabapple *Malus x 'Makamik'*** H: 20-26' W: 16-20' Zone: 2 Full Sun  
 Large, pink-red blooms mature to small, purple red fruit. Bronze foliage turns yellow orange in fall.

 Pink spring blooms turn into small, purple-red fruit. Purple foliage matures to green-bronze, then yellow in fall.

**Columnar Purple Spire Columnar Crabapple *Malus x adstringens 'Jefspire'*** H: 20' W: 6-7' Zone: 3 Full Sun  
 Compact, columnar tree with purple foliage. Few pink spring blooms; sparse purple fruit. Low-maintenance and hardy.

**Rosthern Crabapple *Malus baccata 'Rosthern'*** H: 16-20' W: 6-10' Zone: 2 Full Sun Available in caliper size  
 White spring blooms mature to small, red fruit. Columnar growth habit. Green foliage. Very hardy.

**Weeping Rosy Glo Weeping Crabapple *Malus 'Weeping Rosy Glo'*** H: 8-12' W: 8-10' Zone: 2 Full Sun  
 Bright pink spring blooms turn into small purple fruit. Weeping branches; bronze-green foliage. Small specimen tree.

**Spring Snow Crabapple *Malus x 'Spring Snow'*** H: 20-26' W: 13-16' Zone: 2 Full Sun Available in caliper size  
 Fruitless, rounded tree. Pink buds open to fragrant white spring blooms. Glossy green foliage.

**Starlite Crabapple *Malus x 'Jeflite'*** H: 20-26' W: 13-16' Zone: 2 Full Sun Available in caliper size  
 Red buds open to white blooms. Tiny red fruit persists into winter. Upright, dense tree with green foliage.

 Dark pink spring blooms mature to small, purple-red fruit. Purple foliage on a rounded, spreading canopy.

**American Elm *Ulmus americana*** H: 50-60' W: 40-50' Zone: 3 Full Sun  
 Fast growing tree with a vase-shaped, spreading canopy. Green, toothed foliage turns yellow in fall.

**Brandon Elm *Ulmus americana 'Brandon'*** H: 50-60' W: 30-33' Zone: 3 Full Sun Available in caliper size  
 Fast growing, vase shaped tree. Dark green, toothed foliage. Great shade or boulevard tree: plant 12-15' apart.

**Northern Empress Japanese Elm *Ulmus davidiana japonica 'Burgundy Glow'*** H: 25-30' W: 20-25' Zone: 3 Full Sun  
 Oval shaped canopy with dark green foliage that turns orange to burgundy-red in fall. Dutch Elm disease resistant.

**Snowbird Hawthorn *Crataegus x mordenensis 'Snowbird'*** H: 20' W: 16-20' Zone: 3 Full Sun  
 Glossy green, lobed foliage. Showy, double white spring flowers turn into ornamental red berries. Spreading canopy.

**Toba Hawthorn *Crataegus x mordenensis 'Toba'*** H: 20' W: 16-20' Zone: 3 Full Sun Available in caliper size  
 Glossy green, lobed foliage. Showy, double pink flowers turn into ornamental red berries. Upright spreading canopy.

**Northern Acclaim Honeylocust *Gleditsia triacanthos 'Harve'*** H: 36' W: 33' Zone: 3 Full Sun Available in caliper size  
 Compound green foliage on horizontally tiered branches. Yellow fall colour. Seedless. Specimen tree for sheltered areas.

**Lilac Tree *Syringa*** 5 gal \$99.95 7 gal \$129.95 10 gal \$179.95 15 gal \$239.95 Drought tolerant.

**Ivory Silk Tree Lilac *Syringa reticulata 'Ivory Silk'*** H: 23-26' W: 16-20' Zone: 3 Full Sun Available in caliper size  
 Masses of creamy-white lilac blooms in early summer. Dense, dark green, heart shaped foliage. Non-suckering.

**Japanese Tree Lilac *Syringa reticulata*** H: 16-20' W: 16-20' Zone: 3 Full Sun Available in caliper size  
 Showy, creamy-white lilac blooms in early summer. Small, dense tree with green, heart shaped foliage. Non-suckering.

**Snowdance Japanese Tree Lilac *Syringa reticulata 'Bailnce'*** H: 16-20' W: 16-20' Zone: 3 Full Sun  
 Many creamy white lilac blooms in early summer. Rounded tree; green foliage. Few seed heads produced, non-suckering.

**Corinthian Little Leaf Linden *Tilia cordata 'Corzam'*** H: 40-46' W: 13-16' Zone: 3 Full Sun  
 Thick, heart shaped foliage on a narrow, dense tree. Clusters of yellow, early summer flowers. Low maintenance.

**Dropmore Linden *Tilia x flavescens 'Dropmore'*** H: 33-40' W: 23-33' Zone: 3 Full Sun Available in caliper size  
 Tall, pyramidal, low maintenance tree. Heart shaped, dense green foliage; clusters of yellow flowers. Very hardy.

**Greenspire Linden *Tilia cordata 'Greenspire'*** H: 40-46' W: 25-30' Zone: 3 Full Sun  
 Pyramidal tree with dense, heart shaped, dark green foliage. Clusters of fragrant yellow flowers in early summer.

**Little Leaf Linden *Tilia cordata*** H: 30' W: 26' Zone: 3 Full Sun  
 Pyramidal, low maintenance tree with dense, heart shaped green leaves. Clusters of yellow flowers in early summer.

**Lone Star Linden *Tilia cordata 'BySkinner'*** H: 30-40' W: 20-23' Zone: 23 Full Sun  
 Densely pyramidal tree; heart-shaped, glossy green foliage is yellow in fall. Fragrant, yellow flower clusters in early summer.

**True North American Linden *Tilia americana 'Duros'*** H: 40-50' W: 15-20' Zone: 2 Full Sun  
 Narrow, pyramidal tree; large, heart-shaped green foliage. Fragrant, yellow bloom clusters. Doesn't tolerate drought.

**Amur Maple *Acer ginnala*** H: 16-20' W: 12-16' Zone: 3 Full to Part Sun Available in caliper size  
 Small, graceful tree with lobed green foliage that turns a bright orange to scarlet-red in fall. Very hardy. Prefers acidic soil.

**Autumn Blaze Maple *Acer x freemanii 'Jeffersred'*** H: 50' W: 40' Zone: 4 Full Sun NO GUARANTEE  
 Deeply-lobed green foliage turns brilliant red in fall. Plant in a wind-protected, south-facing, sheltered location.

**Crimson King Norway Maple *Acer platanoides 'Crimson King'*** H: 33-40' W: 26-30' Zone: 4 Full Sun NO GUARANTEE

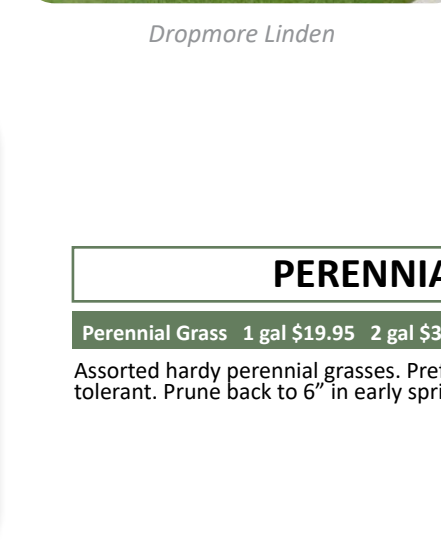

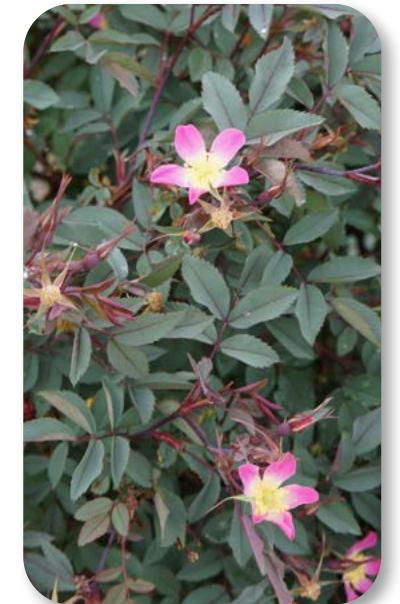

Several different varieties of edible apple grafted onto one single stem for cross-pollination: doesn't require another tree.

Green with red stripes, 2.5" fruit; creamy-green, crisp, juicy flesh. Ripens August. Good eating and juicing.

Green with red blush, 2.5" fruit; green-white, crisp, sweet flesh. Ripens early Sept. Fresh eating, cooking. Stores well.
